



# WSFA FIRE POSTER CONTEST

The National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA®) – the official sponsor of Fire Prevention Week for more than 100 years – has announced “**Charge into Fire Safety™: Lithium-Ion Batteries in Your Home**” as the theme for Fire Prevention Week™, October 5-11, 2025.

## The Details:

Participating member departments each hold their own contest, judge those entries from 4K through 8th grade and **submit only the first-place winner for each grade level** to the WSFA office.

Only one poster per each grade level from a school or fire department will be accepted. Multiple entries per grade will disqualify all entries, even if a school has more than one class at a specific grade level.

The posters will be displayed and judged by the membership in attendance at the WSFA convention March 12-14, 2026, at the KI Center in Green Bay, WI.

Winners will be selected based on originality and their understanding of fire prevention strategies.

**Cash prizes will be awarded in each grade level as follows:**

**First Place: \$50/Second Place: \$25/Third Place: \$10**

## Eligibility Requirements:

Grades 4K through eight are eligible.

All entries must be original and drawn free hand by the student. Traced, stenciled or laminated entries will be disqualified or returned.

Posters are on white poster paper, size 11” x 17” or 12” x 18”

No identification of any sort, including city, fire department, etc. will be allowed on the front of the posters.

**Place a typewritten sticker on the back of each poster with the following information:**

- **Sponsoring Fire Dept name and address**
- **School name**
- **Student Name**
- **Grade Level**
